



CCPS SCHOOL BUS

Dear Parents,

Please find attached the bus route for the CCPS School bus.

If you would like to use the bus this year, please follow the following steps:

1. EMAIL THE SIGNED BUS CODE OF CONDUCT FORM

To book a place on the bus please sign the attached Bus Code of Conduct Form and return it to Administration via email: admin@ccps.qld.edu.au and advise which bus stop/s your student plans to use and the date of the first trip.

2. INSTALL THE BUSMINDER PARENT APP

Caloundra City Private School is very excited to be using the BusMinder Parent app in 2024.

This app has many useful features for parents including bus booking management, a secure payment facility, and the ability to view the real-time location of the school bus.



The BusMinder Parent app can be downloaded from the Apple App Store (for Apple devices) or Google Play Store (for Android devices).

3. SET UP YOUR PAYMENT DETAILS AND BOOKINGS ON THE APP

This User Guide includes information about routes, live tracking, adding an absence, booking through the app, and making payments in the app.

Here are a few quick tips for setting up and using the app:

- To set up BusMinder on your phone, click on *Login*, then '*Forgot your password?*'. This will enable you to set your own password.
- Once you have logged in, you will be asked whether the app should be allowed to send you notifications. We strongly encourage you to **allow** notifications to enable you to see the location of the bus in real-time, which will help you determine the appropriate time to drop your child(ren) at the pick-up location, or to meet the bus in the afternoon.
- BusMinder can also alert when your child boards the bus in the morning and boards and alights the bus in the afternoon.
- The Parent app also contains an alert feature that can be used to send push notifications to your smartphone for example major delays to the route, or if a replacement bus is being used for the trip. Please do not log out of the app.

Payment for Bus - All bus payments will be made via the BusMinder App. No bus passes will be issued by School Administration.

How to set up Bookings using the Parent APP

Parents can now book their students on a route and stop via the parent app.

Beginning at the route screen, then selecting their student, then onto the calendar and then confirmation. You can follow the steps via the app or see a short video below.

How does the system work/what will my child need to do?

Student ID cards will be used as BusMinder cards. For students traveling to school via bus on the first day of term, their card will be given to them by the bus driver on this morning, otherwise they can be collected from the Admin office before the first trip.

Please note: **It is important that students have their ID Card with them each time they travel and they tap on and off in the morning and then tap on and off in the afternoon.**

As students board the bus, they **tap their Student ID card** against the BusMinder unit which records their name, location and boarding time. This ‘tap’ will provide parents with information that their student(s) have boarded or departed the bus via the BusMinder app notification.

All student ‘Tap On’ and ‘Tap Off’ information is available to the school in real-time.

IMPORTANT:

Please ensure to adhere to the below cut off times for changes to prevent delays and confusion for the Bus Driver.

Cut off times for morning changes: 6:45am (before the bus driver commences the route)

Cut off times for afternoon changes: 2:30pm

MORNING BUS SCHEDULE

Turn left onto Pelican Waters Blvd and travel to Caloundra Road Roundabout. Turn left. Follow Caloundra Road and turn left into Bellvista Blvd.

2. 7:11am Bus stop – Bellvista Blvd just past Dumbarton Drive

Follow Bellvista Blvd onto Aura Blvd

3. 7:13am Bus stop – Aura Blvd just past Baringa Tavern

4. 7:17am Bus Stop – Mcarthur Parade/Aura Blvd

5. 7:22am Bus Stop – Banya Ave/Lady Elliott Ave, northside

6. 7:23am Bus Stop - Park Ave/Aura Blvd Heading North

Follow Parklands Blvd

Turn left into Saffron Drive. Follow Safron Drive and turn left into Creekside Blvd. Follow until traffic lights. Turn left into Woodlands Blvd and the next right at the lights to Woodlands Blvd

12. 7:45am Bus Stop - Pacific Lutheran College

U turn at roundabout and travel back along Woodland Blvd. Turn left and then left onto Kawana Way. Travel 1km and turn right into Doherty Street and left into Florey Blvd.

13. 7:46am Bus Stop – Sunshine Coast University Hospital, Doherty St, Birtinya

14. 7:50am Pull off area- Number 57 The Decks near Batten Street, Wurtulla

Follow the Decks then turn right onto Lake Kawana Blvd and then right onto Nicklin Way

15. 7:58am Bus stop - Kawana Bowls Club

16. 7:59am Bus stop – Nicklin Way at Park Haven

17. 8:00am Bus stop – Wurtulla Shopping Village

Follow Nicklin Way and turn left into Beerburrum Street. Follow onto Elizabeth Street and Buccleugh Street

18. 8:20am Arrive CCPS-drop off

Bus Code of Conduct

Caloundra City Private School provides a school bus to transport its students to and from School excursions. The following Bus Code of Conduct is based on the School's Code of Conduct principles of Care, Courtesy, Respect and Responsibility.

It is a requirement of the School that all students agree to the Code of Conduct as set out below. Consequences of non-compliance with the code may result in a student not being able to ride on the bus.

Students are required to;

Respect other people and their property

- Follow the Bus drivers and Teachers/Teacher Aide's instructions without argument.
- Treat other people and their possessions with respect.
- Not interfere with the bus or other people's property.

Wait for the bus in an orderly manner

- Stand quietly without calling out or shouting.
- Not push other people in line.
- Please be punctual. The bus will wait no longer than 2mins at each stop.

While on the bus conduct yourself in an orderly manner

- Always follow instructions from the driver.
- Sit properly on the bus with bottom on the seat.
- Wear the supplied seat belt correctly.
- No food or drink to be consumed while travelling on the bus.
- Store school bags under the seat.
- Speak quietly.

Get off the bus in an orderly manner

- Wait until the bus stops before standing to get off.
- Get off the bus in a quiet and orderly fashion.
- Never cross the road in front of the bus.

I agree to support and uphold the Caloundra City Private School Bus Code of Conduct. I understand that if the code is not followed, it may mean that I will be refused bus travel.
